Meeting held 7pm January 15, 2013 Coalmont Hotel

18 people in attendance.

Minutes read from last meeting. Motion to adopt as read – Ed Staples Seconded Chris Goodfellow.

Treasurers report given. Motion to adopt as read – Lori Rice Seconded – Anne Jones

Report on KVR signs given by Chris Goodfellow. Signs to be purchased from The Emporium in reflective metal. Posts to be purchased from Ernie Rice. Total cost \$794.00. Motion to accept – Nienke Klaiver. Seconded – John Moss.

Cemetery maintenance report given by Chris Goodfellow. 50 large trees have been removed with about 30-40 remaining to be removed. Plot damaged by the wind falling a large tree has been repaired and repairs to Hattie's grave stone were completed this summer. Chris advised on the work needed to fall 2 most problematic trees that remain standing.

RDOS issues discussed by Brad Hope. The dump at the end of Main is still an issue with the current mechanism to fix the problem not working. Garbage stickers now not dated so no way to access Area H use. Property assessments are down but the mil rate is up so taxes will remain the same. There are forestry monies available to Area H for community projects. It will be available in April and CCA will meet 3rd week of February to set up committee for how Coalmont would like to receive and use any monies that are available. Community centre discussed. Securing park at entrance to Coalmont and Granite Creek land use also discussed.

Hospital and rural health care report given by Ed Staples. He gave an overview of SOHC (Save our Hospital Coalition) and a report on Community Consultation to be held January 29th. Ole Juul appointed representative for Coalmont at the Consultation.

New items discussed were signs at the Blakeburn town site. Bert Rice to contact someone to get more info for signage. Also discussed was the future of the hotel and the need for a new meeting place.
