Minutes read from last meeting.  
Treasurer's report given.

Minutes accepted as read – Motion to accept by Ernie Rice, seconded by Eileen Walsh.

Elections were to be held in July but as there was not a quorum elections will now be held at the January meeting. Ann Jones has resigned as Secretary. No one volunteered to take on these duties so this will also be on the table in January. Penny Goodfellow nominated to take on the secretarial duties again. She declined nomination. Motion for nominations and elections to be held in January made by Faye Davidson and seconded by Eileen Walsh.

Brad Hope relayed parting words to the group regarding working with the C.C.A. and its formation during his directorship. He was happy to hear that an all candidates meeting was going to be held in Coalmont so that we would continue to be represented in Area H. The community property is still with the province. The license of occupation will be held by the RDOS.

The Stout/Dixon family have taken the first steps to donate the property on the East side (opposite the park) to the RDOS. This will give the community the opportunity to have input on the use of the property re: development of a park. Brad Hope had a map of the piece of property for viewing. It was tabled that once this transfer has been completed that a Thank You card from the C.C.A. should be sent to the Stout/Dixon family for their generous contribution to the community.

Brad touched on the ongoing medical issues still being worked on. Ambulance dispatching is a current issue and discussing ensued about the development of a helicopter pad in our area.

Brad Hope was thanked and given a round of applause for all his hard work in the past years.
