

Coalmont Community Association Minutes

Attendance 15 persons

Bob Coyne informs us that the job of clearing the slide which is blocking the KVR is put out for tender.

Word from Stout family indicates that they reject the idea of a helicopter landing and large structures on their pending land donation and would like to see it used for parkland only. It was decided that we could however proceed with the idea of a helicopter landing on crown land which would therefore provide a compelling reason for its acquisition.

Discussion about increasing the number of meetings from 4 to 6 per year and alternating days in order to give more people a chance to participate. It was felt that more days was not acceptable but that alternate days was.

MSC: Every three months alternating days.

Motion to reduce the quorum when voting at meetings from 15 to 12.

Moved, Seconded, and Carried.

MSC: Motion to increase allotment for Chris and Sylvia for next meeting.

The idea of a covered space to be built on the Stout land where the railway station used to be and in the profile of the old station was discussed. In cases of emergency, this could be used as a muster station and could have an air horn. The regular use of the facility would be a resting place and picnic area for tourists.
